


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

Our tour guide welcomes you at your hotel in Hanoi Old Quarter. We make a journey to western of Hanoi to Duong Lam village, a purely agricultural village in the Red River delta where still preserves many hundred-year-old houses.

Only by walking along tiny ancient alleys, can you feel the peaceful ambience of old northern villages. We'll visit Mong Phu temple in Mong Phu hamlet - the only hamlet whose original village entrance gate remains intact, dedicated to national heroes. Have some talks with the locals in their ancient houses.

We continue driving to visit Mia pagoda, built in the 15th century, and admire 287 statues of all sizes, among which are famous sculptures such as Buddha statue in the Himalayas and the statues of the Eight Vajra Deities.

On the way back to Hanoi, we'll stop at Van Phuc Silk village. The village by Nhue River is renowned for its traditional weaving and premium quality silk products.

Leisurely walk to Ca tru Singing House and be ready for indulging in 500-year-old melodies in an intimate atmosphere of traditional Vietnamese house.

You may take a chance to learn using music instruments after the show. Get back to your hotel and goodbye your guide.

We arrive at Hoa Lu which was once the ancient capital of Viet Nam in the 10th and 11th century. The visit to temples of Dinh and Le offers you deep understanding of Vietnam's history under Dinh, Le & Ly dynasties and insight of ancient architectural values.

After lunch in a local restaurant, we take a boat trip to visit Trang An which is a gathering of 31 valleys, 50 cross-water caves, and home to a wide range of rare flora and fauna. We'll row through Trang An grottos quietly, enjoy fresh air and the sound of in the middle of magnificent forested mountains.

Then get on a small sampan to visit Thung Nham bird park, discover the most features of this area with more than 4000 birds of 40 species flying to inhabit every day. Your best chance to take nice photos.

We also explore Hang But (Buddhist Cave), about 500m in length, magical view of the stalactites and stalagmites, including a big Buddha-shaped stalactite sitting beside an underground river, as well as visit orchard of tropical fruits in this area.

Return to Hanoi in late evening. End this bird watching tour at your hotel around 19:00.

- Surrounding the mountainous area of Sapa is some of the most breathtaking scenery in Vietnam. There are
  a number of ethnic minority hill tribes whose culture and way of life are truly amazing. The tours give you a
  chance to observe and experience the reality and wonder of these communities.
- In the 3-4hour walking (half day tour) or 4-7hour walking (full day tour), you will have the opportunity to get close to the intriguing and fascinating ethnic hill tribe communities.
- Lunch, which is provided on the full day tours, is normally served in a local house or as lunch box on a nice spot.







#### INTINERARY

The trip commences with car driving to Silver Waterfall where you can enjoy the stunning views of the surrounding mountains and the lush green forests belonging to Hoang Lien National Park. Along the way, you will experience a large farming area where local grows vegetable, fruit and flower. After spending sometime at Silver Waterfall, your ride will continue for few more kilometers to the gate of Hoang Lien national park, where you will take a short walk access into the jungle to visit the Love Waterfall. The area is covered by trees, lush green forest and a beautiful the water falling from rocky cove. Enjoy the great time by listening to the sound of the waterfall, deep your feet in to the cool water that makes you feel very relaxing.

Leave the waterfall by walking back to vehicle then you have short drive to visit Heaven Gate – The highest Pass in Vietnam. At the height of 2000m above sea level you have chance to enjoy the spectacular view of the Pass, mountainous and valley below which direct to Lai Chau province. You then finish your trip by driving back to Sapa town.

**Approx:** 1 hour driving; 2.4 km walking/1 hour; 1 hour visiting Waterfall and Haven Gate.

#### OVERVIEW

The trip offers you a chance to visit the highest Pass in Vietnam and admire the spectacular view of mountain landscape and visiting pretty Silver Waterfall.

A nice walk to Hoang Lien National Park and Love Waterfall, where is covered by rain forest with trees, lush green bamboo and herbal plants.



#### NOTES

Ta Phin is a unique village where two ethnic groups, Black H'mong and Red Dao community, live their own way with no cultural mixture.

You will experience how different their culture is compared with Kinh people's lifestyles when visiting local houses.



#### NOTES

Red Dao women will try to sell handicraft at the village so this tour would not be recommended if you prefer "off the bitten track" tours. Good road conditions.

#### INTINERARY

Your journey will start by driving downhill towards Lao Cai before turning left into a byroad leading to Ta Phin village.

Here you can involve in the unique cultural life of Black H'mong and Red Dao minorities, the two largest ethnic groups in the area living happily together while still maintaining their own customs.

The two groups, who are both well-known for handicraft, are recognized by their costumes. You will take a walk around the village and visit one of their local houses, then have a transfer back to Sapa.

Approx: Grade 1 of 5/1 hour driving/ 1.5 hours walking.

#### INTINERARY

The short journey will commence with a drive southwards Muong Hoa valley. You will then start your descending walk into the valley, which is the largest paddy terrace in Sapa area.

The guide provides you interesting information about growing crops, especially rice. If you visit the valley between May and October, it is likely for you to come across how the locals do planting and harvesting, the most important activities in their daily life.

The walk takes you from Lao Chai village of Black H'mong minority to Ta Van village of Giay minority, also a stop at a local school. After visiting Ta Van the vehicle will take you back to Sapa.

Approx: Grade 2 of 5/1 hour driving/2 hours walking.

#### OVERVIEW

On the way you will learn more about the different process from when the rice seedling is transplanted until it is served as steam rice on the dinner table.

You will have opportunity to experience the daily life of Black H'mong and Giay minorities.



#### NOTES

This is the only place in Sapa where you can meet Giay minority. Be aware that the trail can be muddy and slippery in rainy period. You are often followed by the children trying to sell souvenirs.

You will do a trek through one of the most beautiful part of Sapa valley with magnificent landscapes surrounded by terraced rice paddies, waterfalls and mountains.

The trek on dirt trails and paths among such amazing nature also offers you a great benefit for both your physical and mental health.



#### NOTES

Be aware that in rainy period the trail can be slippery.

#### INTINERARY

The trip commences from Sapa with a 15-minute drive to the trekking point. There you start your descending walk on a dirt path through rice terraces to a suspension bridge which connects two paths of the Black H'mong village of Y Linh Ho.

You will visit the village before taking a rest by the riverbank for fruit and crackers while enjoying the picturesque view of the Muong Hoa valley.

You then continue your trek up and down hill on a river-side mountain path, heading to Cat Cat village. Upon arrival to the village, you will walk up the steps before meeting your driver and having a transfer back to Sapa.

Approx: Grade 2 of 5/30 minutes driving/2.5 hours walking.

#### INTINERARY

This trip commences with a short walk through the town of Sapa before turning on a footpath crossing vegetable gardens. You then descend down the valley on a dirt trail through rice paddy terraces, enjoying the spectacular scenery on the way.

Once reaching the narrow river running at the bottom of the valley, you will walk along the riverbank before arriving at Y Linh Ho village of Black H'mong minority. Here you take a rest and have a lunch nearby the river.

After lunch, the walk takes you deeper into Muong Hoa valley. You will pass through Lao Chai village of Black H'mong minority and then Ta Van village of Giay minority by following a popular trekking route. At Ta Van, you walk up to the main road and have a transfer back to Sapa.

**Approx:** Grade 2 of 5/30 minutes driving/5 hours walking. **Meal:** Lunch.



- Cua Tung beach: the river flows from west to east just south of the 17th parallel and close to the northern border of Quang Tri Province.
- Vinh Moc tunnels: The complex of tunnel, located deep in the Vietnamese Demilitarized Zone, including wells, kitchens, rooms for each family and spaces for healthcare. Back to Hue in late afternoon. End the tour.
