Introduction

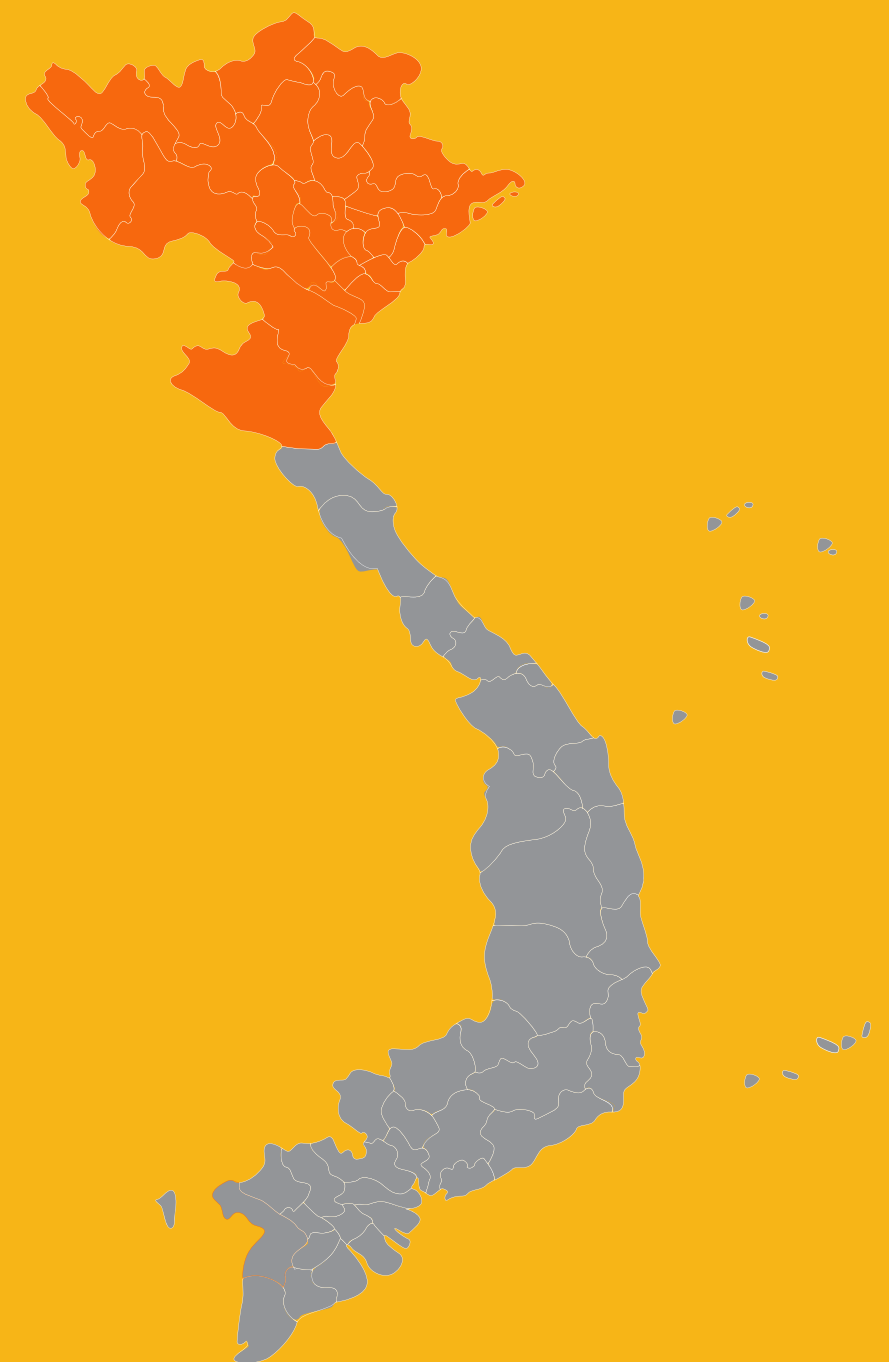

Visiting 'Ha Noi Hilton' Prison

Where the French once imprisoned and executed many Vietnamese revolutionaries, the infamous 'Ha Noi Hilton' prison is now a museum that exhibits the brutal French colonial regime and struggle of the Vietnamese people against imperial rule.



Watching a water puppet show

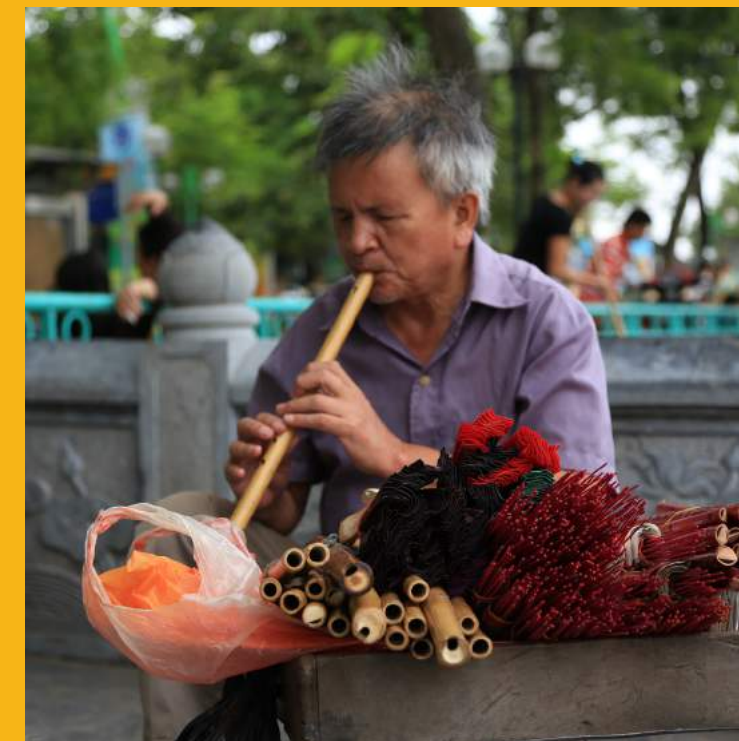
While away the time with this delightful traditional performance art form and watch lacquered wooden puppets "dancing on the water" to a Vietnamese orchestra.



Exploring the Old Quarter

Enjoy uninterrupted stretches of colonial architecture that give the city its understated charm. Venture into the heart of the old quarter, down narrow walkways and backstreets.

Try some of the fresh beer “Bia Hoi” at one of the local establishments and get an authentic taste of Hanoi’s tantalizing street food scene.



Visiting Ho Chi Minh’s Mausoleum

Learn all about the life and legend of ‘Uncle Ho’ at his former home and mausoleum.

Deep inside the monumental marble edifice of the mausoleum rests the pale entombed body of Ho Chi Minh himself. Rules of respect are strictly adhered to.





Visiting the Temple of Literature

Step away from the busy streets and into the ancient Confucian temple and spiritual retreat. This is where the country's first university was founded in the 11th century and where noble-born or gifted scholars would go to study Confucianism, literature and poetry.



Visiting Bat Trang ceramics village

The ancient village of Bat Trang lies on the Red River just 13 kilometres from Hanoi. This quaint low rise town is an excellent place to wander down the narrow streets to traditional ceramic shops and pottery markets. Visit the original brick kilns (Lo Bau) and watch the local craftspeople create hand-painted plates, vases, mugs and bowls.

■ Trekking in Hoang Lien National Park

Venture into the unspoiled rugged landscape of Hoang Lien National Park, rich and diverse in fauna and flora, and surrounded by rainforest mountains. Walking through villages of the hill tribe minorities and you also get a glimpse of the rich cultural beauty of the region.



Walking through valleys to waterfalls and up to mountain peaks

The mountainous area of Sapa has some of the most dramatic scenery in Vietnam. The tours give you a chance to observe and experience the extraordinary way of life of the hill tribe communities that live here while taking in stunning views of the surrounding mountains and lush forests.

Visiting Black Hmong community-based tourism villages

Walk through the villages of the Black Hmong, one of the largest hill tribes in Sapa, famous for their silver necklaces and indigo blue colored clothes made from hemp. Get immersed in their villages and gain a deeper insight into the lives of this unique people.



Hiking up Fansipan mountain

Trek through one of the most picturesque parts of the Sapa valley surrounded by terraced paddies, waterfalls and mountains. Being the highest peak in Indochina, this is a strenuous hike along dirt trails and paths with awe-inspiring nature.



Meet Red Giao villagers

The Red Dao minority villages in Thanh Kim commune are among the few that remain largely unimpacted by tourism.

Walk through bare hills, rice terraces and villages, and experience the real lives, breathtaking views and natural beauty in such mountainous terrain.



Biking on mountain roads

Our mountain biking tours are well designed so you will not only ride in natural areas with beautiful scenery, but also go trekking and visit markets and villages where you can learn more about the country and its cultural heritage.

Discover local specialities each with their own unique preparation, such as Ha Long squid sausage and Cai Rong fish.



Exploring the thousands of limestone islands by boat

Immerse yourself in this majestic landscape and World Heritage site of papaya-green waters and scattered limestone outcrops. Take the time to relax, enjoy the scenery and feast on fresh seafood, while navigating the islands and bay waters on an eco-friendly boat tour.



Visiting floating villages in the bay

Ha Long Bay is a rich marine resource and the floating fishing villages have been around for hundreds of years. Escape to this calm and peaceful natural wonder and gain a unique insight into the country's cultural heritage.

Exploring the Trang An river by boat

With dramatic karst mountains, the landscapes around Ninh Binh are renowned for their timeless beauty. Venture by boat into the caves and waterways of this region, classified as a World Heritage site since 2014.



Discovering the Tam Coc caves

Navigate your way down the Ngo Dong River by rowing boat past limestone outcrops and peaceful rice paddies and explore the caves of Tam Coc at your own leisurely pace. Keep a look out for the Bich Dong mountain pagodas that are also found in this area.



Visiting Bai Dinh Temple

Bai Dinh is the biggest pagoda in Vietnam, consisting of new, gigantic and imposing temples and ancient shrines. Resting atop the 200-meter mountain you can walk among the dense Bodhi trees and visit the biggest bronze Buddha statue in Vietnam, weighing 100 tons.

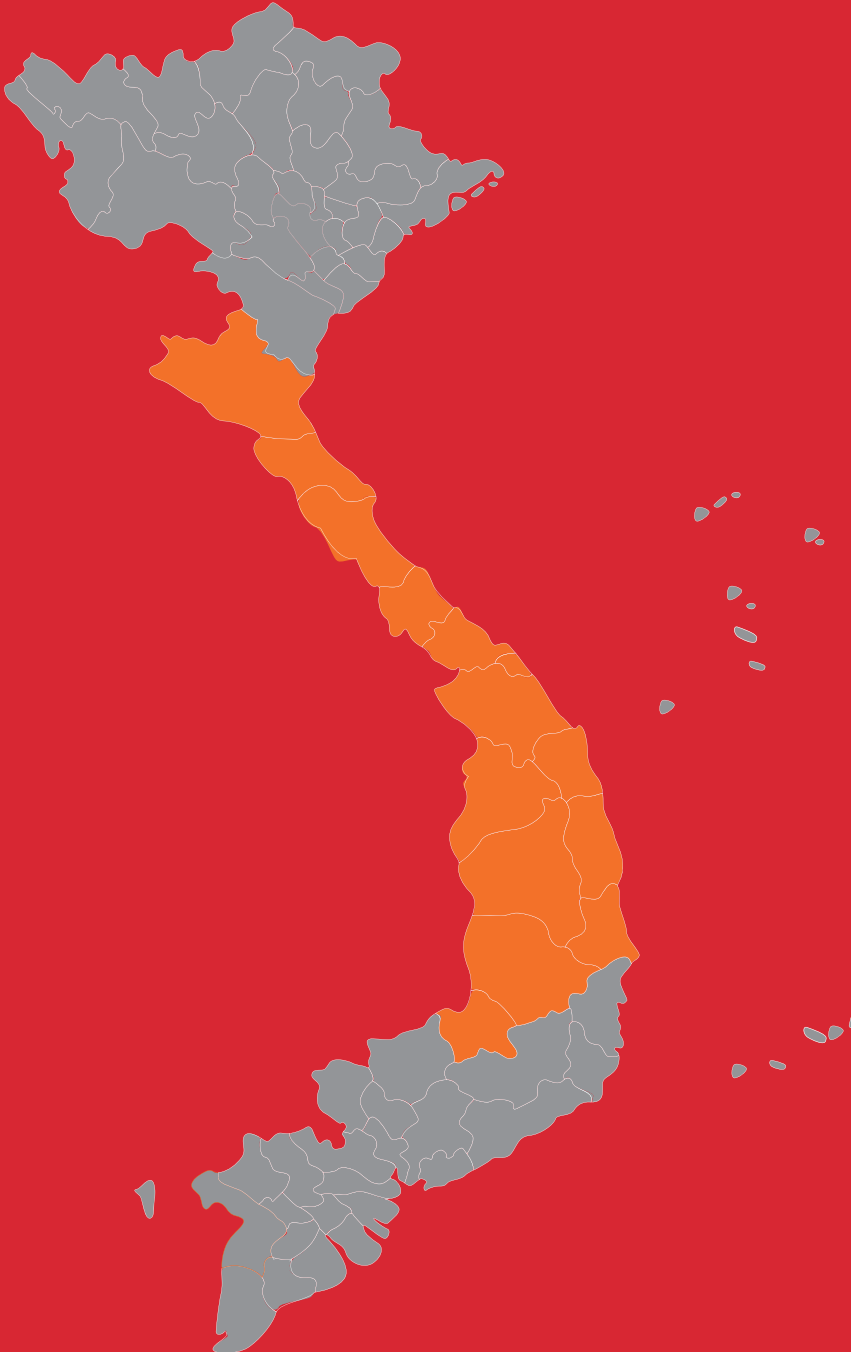

Exploring the Ancient Citadel

A moat and thick stone walls surround the 19th -century Citadel, a sprawling complex of the Imperial City, with palaces, shrines and a theater. Explore gates, temples, pavilions, shops and museums and galleries featuring art and costumes from various periods of Vietnamese history.



Visiting Thien Mu Pagoda

Built on a hillock overlooking the Perfume River, and nestled behind a flower garden and peaceful pine forest, the seven-stories high octagonal temple stands tall. An icon of Vietnam and the official symbol of Hue, the pagoda houses precious antiques, and fine gold and silver images of Buddha.



Visiting hat and incense craft villages

Stop over at a craft village and observe how locals make sandalwood and cinnamon incense as well as traditional Hue conical hats from bamboo. Incense sticks are tied together in colorful bunches and lit, giving off a pleasant aroma.

Taking a boat trip on the Perfume River

Cruise the waterways by dragon boat, visiting villages and viewing daily life along the way.

The river is one of the main charms of the city, bringing with it the fragrances of flowers from the countryside.



Exploring the city by bicycle

Discover the city by bicycle and get the chance to visit the citadel, several temples and tombs, traditional craft making villages, and local markets. Enjoy sampling the cuisine and meeting the locals on your way, as you take in the peaceful surroundings.



Visiting the war buildings and artifacts at the DMZ

War remnants can be found in a forested strip of land on the 17th parallel north referred to as the De-Militarized Zone (DMZ).

Meant to serve as a buffer zone between North and South Vietnam (1954-1975), ironically it is where some of the most brutal fighting took place.



Fishing at Tam Giang Lagoon

Learn about the traditional fishing methods on the picturesque lagoon rich with beautiful coral and marine life in their natural habitat.

You might try your hand at fishing or simply relax on a boat or floating house and enjoy a typical seafood dinner while watching the sunset.



Visiting Tu Duc Tomb

Tu Duc designed the exquisitely harmonious tomb which was constructed between 1864 and 1867, for use both before and after his death. One of the most impressive mausoleums of the Nguyen Dynasty, the tomb lies in an expansive pine forest, 8 km outside of Hue.

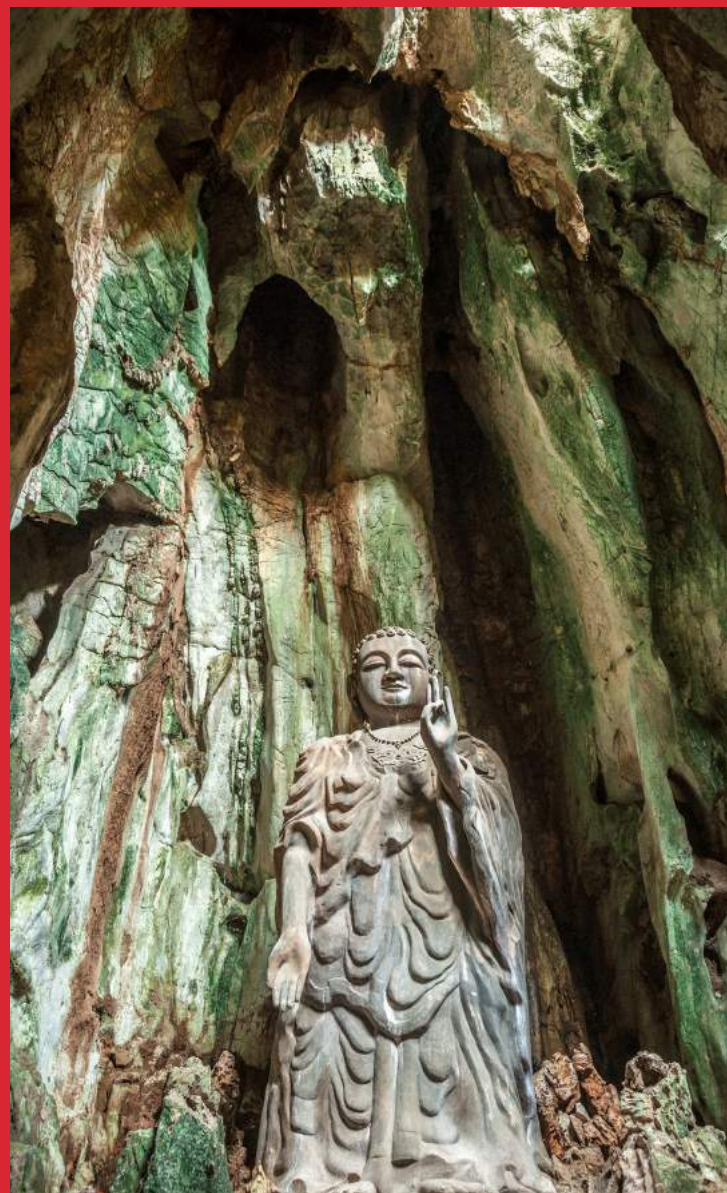
Relaxing on long pristine white beaches

Walk along sandy beaches and take in the pristine natural beauty of Da Nang's long, relatively uncrowded and undisturbed shoreline. Sample the local seafood, sip on a coconut and take a rest in the shade of a palm frond umbrella.



Visiting the Cham Museum of Sculpture

Contemplate the rich cultural history of Vietnam and pay a visit to world's largest collection of artifacts of the Cham civilization. Ornate mythical Hindu sculptures and animal figure in bronze, sandstone and terracotta are housed within the old standstone walls of the museum.



Exploring the caves at the Marble Mountains

Descend into the caverns of Phù cave or "Buddhist hell" at the foot of the mountain and on the pathway up, you will pass through caves that hold Cham altars and Buddhist shrines, and a stunning vaulted cave, Huyen Khong or "light room," on the journey back down.



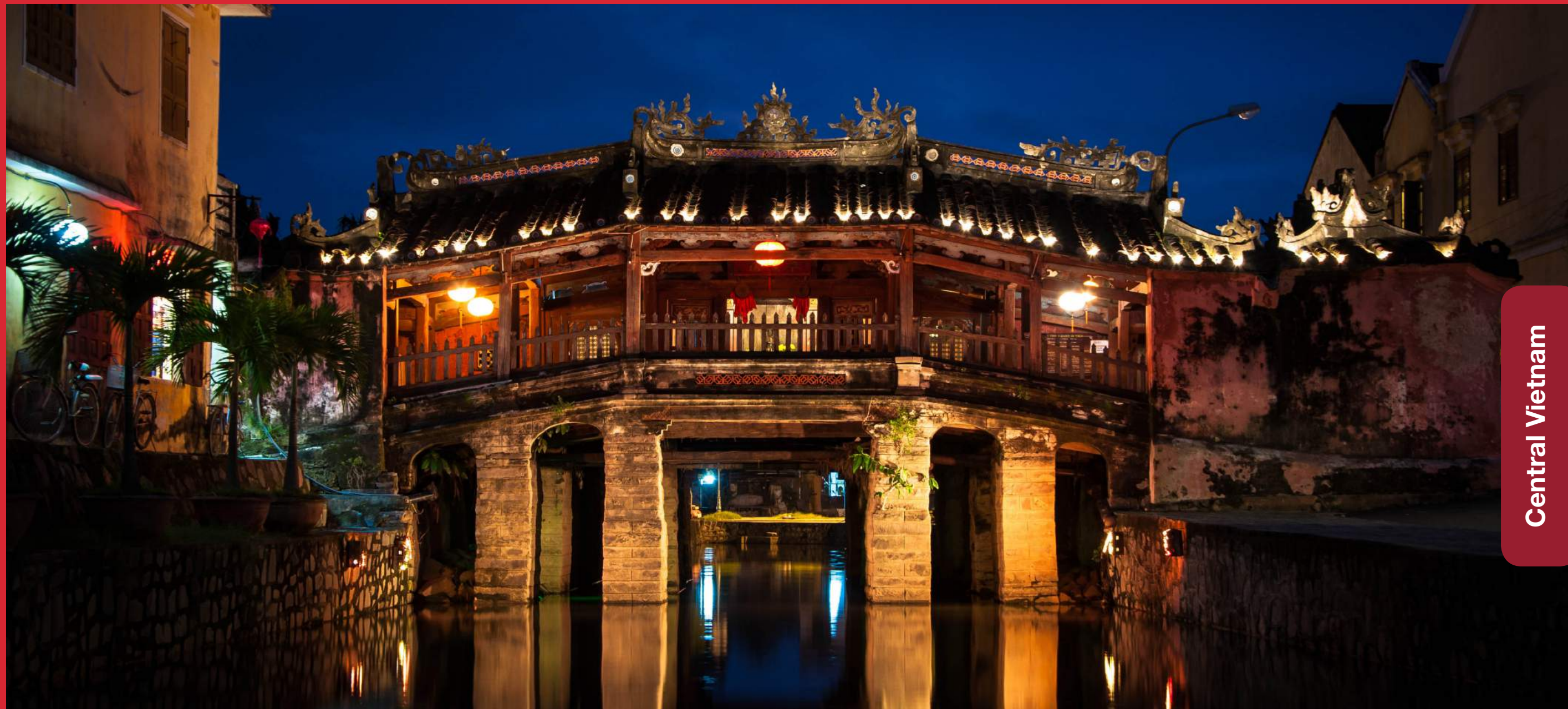
Climbing to the top of the Marble Mountains

A stone stairway carved into the rock leads up to the summit of Thủy Sơn Mountain, ascending higher by the step while coastline and landscape spread out in spectacular views. The final ascent to the peak, The Road to Paradise, can make for a strenuous climb.

■ Taking in the quaint multi-cultural architecture of Hoi An ancient town

A stroll around the ancient town of Hoi An historically known as Faifo on the banks of the Thu Bon River is a must when visiting Central Vietnam. This unique UNESCO World Heritage site was built by settling Chinese, Dutch, French and Japanese traders and merchants between the 15th and 19th centuries. Cycle or walk to wooden Chinese shophouses and temples, French colonial buildings or the centerpiece Japanese Covered Bridge and pagoda

Crafting traditional lanterns

Visit the Hoi An handicraft village and home of a craftsman and learn about the history, shape and colors of the lanterns and the many stages of making them.

Find out how to make this unique traditional craft by crafting your very own souvenir.



Cooking classes

Discover the flavors and secrets of Vietnam's cuisine with a charismatic, fluent chef in the intimacy of a home-based cooking school.

Choose one of 56 mouth-watering dishes, buy the ingredients fresh at the local market in Hoi An and enjoy your creation.



Cycling to Cam Thanh Village

Explore rural life in Hoi An on a responsible tour, meeting with local villagers and observing age-old techniques for the production of rice, rice paper and fish sauce. Enjoy an authentic basket boat ride among the coconut palms and perhaps catch a fish or two.



Floating down the river in a basket boat

Explore tranquil coconut palm-flanked waterways of a post-war river by basket boat, a unique bamboo fishing boat. Learn how to paddle, try your own hand at fishing and enjoy local food on board this special tour.

Learning how rice is made by local farmers

Get behind the scenes of the traditional practices of rice farming and experience “hands-on” what it feels like to be a rice farmer, harvesting the fields, planting rice shoots, watering in the traditional way, and grinding and cooking the rice.



Touring the area on a Vespa

Enjoy a comfortable, stylish and authentic tour experience on the back of a vintage Vespa scooter. Sit back and relax as you journey through the scenic landscapes and countryside of rural Vietnam toward the holy My Son ruins.



Experiencing how local craftsmen make furniture from water coconut and bamboo

Immerse yourself in the stories of local artisans as you try your hand at traditional wood carving and manipulation techniques, used to make all sorts of furniture out of water coconut and bamboo, including chairs, tables, lamps and even bicycles.



Gardening at Tra Que herb village

What better way to get a feel of the local way of life than to get your hands dirty and join the villagers in working the land, fertilizing the soil with seaweed from the local lake, raking, sowing seeds, watering crops and picking greens.



Wandering around the Ancient Champa ruins at My Son

Once an imperial city between the 4th and 12th centuries, the majestic My Son ruins are an impressive complex of architectural works, with temples and towers of intricate red brickwork designed expressly to reflect the divinity of the Champa kingdom.



Riding a water buffalo

Once an integral part of rice farming, used for plowing the fields and pulling heavy wagons, the good natured, friendly and good natured buffalo now carry foreigners through lush-green rice paddies on this fun, unique adventure.



Net fishing with local fishermen

Spend time getting to know the local villagers and fishermen at Cua Dai Beach, a 20-minute drive from Hoi An. Head to the palm-lined beach where you can learn how to cast from a basket boat on the open ocean. Dine on a feast of grilled seafood.

Exploring islands by boat cruises

Explore the islands and discover great opportunities for relaxation whether it be swimming in clear warm waters, fishing, scuba diving among the rich marine life or sunbathing on fine white sandy beaches. Options for jet-skiing are easy to come by and affordable.



Visiting ancient Champa ruins at Po Nagar Towers

Atop Mount Cu Lau on the banks of the River Cai, the temples and four red brick Po Nagar towers (7th - 12th centuries) stand in honor of the Hindu deities. The aroma of incense wafts through its corridors is evidence that Po Nagar is still used as a place of worship today.

Visiting Dam Market

Get a glimpse into the everyday lives of the locals and try your haggling skills in the local Dam Market and tourist hub. Peruse the colourful collection of food and souvenir stalls as you enjoy relatively little hassle from vendors.



Snorkeling

Day trips are available to Nha Trang's beautiful, sandy offshore islands, Hòn Mun and Hòn Tằm. Observe the rich biodiversity of tropical marine life of the marine protected coral reefs and clear warm waters.



Seafood Feasts

All along the coast you can enjoy fresh seafood cooked for you by the local fishermen and their families, at simple shacks with deckchairs right on the beach. Or opt for one of the many restaurants serving the freshest, most scrumptious seafood prepared to your liking.

Enjoying a cable car ride with stunning mountain vistas

Glide across beautifully serene pine forest to the Zen hillside monastery, a peaceful and tranquil Buddhist temple, as a meditation center and spiritual retreat. Self-reliance and self-realization are sought here through the practice of within the native Truc Lam school of Buddhism (13th-14th century).



Visiting Truc Lam Zen Monastery

Glide across beautifully serene pine forest to the Zen hillside monastery, a peaceful and tranquil Buddhist temple, meditation center and spiritual retreat.

Self-reliance and self-realization are sought here through the practice of meditation within the native Truc Lam school of Buddhism (13th-14th century).

Visiting Hang Nga Guesthouse 'Crazy House'

Designed and constructed by Vietnamese architect and designer Mrs. Dang Viet Nga, this unique and surreal guesthouse has been a work in progress since 1990 and is a must-see when visiting Da Lat.

The irregular size and shape rooms are connected by slim bridges, tunnels and ladders so if you are looking to stay somewhere different, Hang Nga Guesthouse, locally known as 'Crazy House' is the place to go.



Looking around Da Lat Train Station

The French art-deco and former cog railway station is a national architectural relic offering tourist rides through the countryside of Da Lat. The restored building and interiors with stylish waiting rooms still have the delightful ambiance of a colonial era.

An open air train ride to Trai Mat Hamlet

Take a scenic 7 km journey around Da Lat's charming countryside to the quaint village of Trai Mat where you can explore the streets, temples and small market. Five trips depart daily from the historical French colonial train station with a minimum of 20 passengers required.



Gardens & pine forested hillsides

Gardens, parks, lakes, and wooded hills and mountains offer an enticing and picturesque landscape reminiscent of the French Alps. Soar across pine forest by cable car or experience some of the best mountain biking, hiking and canyoning in Vietnam.
