### NORTHERN VIETNAM

Northern Vietnam is full of culture and natural wonders. Its three most popular destinations, Hanoi, Ha Long Bay and Sa Pa, are also among the most visited in Vietnam. The origin of Vietnamese culture and history is mostly from this region, especially the area around Hanoi. Its shoreline contains many beautiful islands, some of which are untouched. Many backpackers also favor the impressive landscape in the northern mountains in Ha Giang and Sa Pa. With Hanoi consistently ranking among the world's top 10 destinations by TripAdvisor, the region gets more touristy every day; one can now find European tourists as far as Ha Giang, one of the most remote provinces.

### THE CENTRAL COAST

The Central Coast of Viet Nam is likened by the Vietnamese to the bamboo pole connecting the baskets of North and South. The Truong Son Mountains, which stretch all the way to the coast between Hue and Danang, have traditionally divided the country in two in terms of weather and dialect, although the actual demarcation line during the Vietnam War was slightly higher up at the 17th parallel to the north of Hue.

### THE CENTRAL HIGHLANDS

The Central Highlands of Vietnam are a distinct contrast from the tropical south, with an arid climate, rolling hills, and blue skies. The region sees few foreign visitors, and many of them go to revisit old battlefields or see the indigenous tribes. Besides the pleasant city of Da Lat, it is the scenery and the ethnic minorities living here that draw travelers to this region. Although most people around here, different to their counterparts in the north-west highlands, only don their traditional clothing for special occasions, the shape and structure of the housings is much more diversified and striking. From long houses to bamboo huts, stilt houses and large communal houses, every region and ethnic has its own distinct style. Everyday life is the same simple agricultural routine, and you are likely to get invited for a mug of rice wine rather often.

### SOUTHERN VIETNAM

Southern Vietnam covers the Mekong Delta, the extreme southern end of the Mekong River, and the area around Ho Chi Minh city, Viet Nam.

As all deltas, it receives the bounty of the siltation from the upper Mekong, and as such is a very rich and lush area, covered with rice fields. It produces about half of the total of Vietnam's agricultural output (in fact the delta produces more rice than Korea and Japan altogether), and is the place for timeless sceneries of farmers planting or harvesting rice.

The Mekong splits in Cambodia into two main rivers, the Bassac (Hau Giang) and the First river (Tien Giang), then in Vietnam into a more complex system, creating a maze of small canals, rivers and arroyos interspersed with villages and floating markets.

Life in the Mekong Delta revolves much around the river, and all the villages are often accessible by river as well as by road.

The high times of life in the Mekong delta are the lunar new year (Tet), and the mid-autumn festival (Tet trung thu), where children will set hundreds of candles on their way on the river on as many tiny skiffs. If you know how to take your time, or are guided by an able guide, you will certainly enjoy your stay in the Mekong delta.

### **ALL ABOUT VIETNAM**



### Geography

Viet Nam is one of the most beautiful countries in Asia. It shares borders with China, Laos and Cambodia, and faces the East Sea (South China Sea). Thanks to its location, Viet Nam is the bridge linking Southeast Asian mainland together. It is an S-shaped country, with thousands of offshore islands, the largest archipelagoes of the Hoang Sa (Paracel) islands and the Truong Sa (Spratly) Islands. The country's land area is about 331,051.4 sq.km and lies between East longitudes 102008' and 109028', and North latitudes 8002' and 23023'. Viet Nam offers a 3,260km coastline and its inland borderline is 4,550km. From North to South, the country stretches on about 1,650km.



### Topography

Three quarters of the territory consist of mountainous regions. Viet Nam has two major deltas, the Red River Delta and the Mekong Delta, as well as four distinctive mountainous zones (North East, North West, Northern Truong Son, Southern Truong Son), South-Central Coast, each possessing its own unique features.

### Climate

Viet Nam is located in a tropical and temperate zone. The climate is characterized by a strong monsoon influence, a considerable amount of sunny days, and a high rate of rainfall and humidity. The tropical and the mountainous regions enjoy a temperate climate. The climate in the South of Viet Nam is divided into two distinguished season (from May to November). The four distinct seasons are most evident in the Northern provinces. The annual average temperature in some cities is 24.6oC in Ha Noi, 25.3oC in Hue, about 28oC in Ho Chi Minh City



### People

The Vietnamese population exceeds 90,728,900 (in the year 2014) and is divided into 54 ethnic groups. The largest group, the Viet (King), accounts for 80% of the whole population and is concentrated in lowland areas, whereas most of ethnic minorities live in the high-lands and the mountainous areas.





### Religion

There is no official religion in Viet Nam, but Buddhism is very popular. Buddhist pagodas and Catholic churches generally constitute interesting tourist attractions. Some religions are more specific to the southern regions, such as the Cao Dai sect, the Hoa Hao sect, and Islam. Most Vietnamese worship their ancestors.



### Culture

The Vietnamese culture, endowed with a long and rich heritage, is deeply stamped with national pride. Famous ancient cultures include the Nui Do culture, followed by the Son Vi culture founded over 10,000 years ago, then by the Hoa Binh - Bac Son culture.

The Dong Son culture received the most brilliant development and was deeply connected with the Red River civilization, the wet rice and the emergence of the primeval states (Van Lang - Au Lac in the North; in the Central region, the Sa Huynh culture, which belongs to the Cham people; and in the South, the Oc Eo culture of Phu Nam State).

Despite of historical contingencies, there are still over 40,000 preserved historic and cultural sites over Viet Nam in 2014, thousands of which have been listed as national sites. These relics are concentrated mainly in Ha Noi, Hue, and some other areas such as the relics of the Kings Hung in Phong Chau (Phu Tho Province) date back to the period of the formation of the country. There are also the ancient capital of Hoa Lu (Ninh Binh Province), My Son Sanctuary (Quang Nam Province) ...

Specific features of Viet Nam are likewise reflected in

other cultural tokens such as legends, festivals, costumes and traditional art forms such as Xoan singing, Ca Tru singing, quan ho Bac Ninh folk songs, Vi and Giam folk songs, Don Ca Tai Tu music and songs, classical theatre (Tuong), Cai Luong, popular theatre (Cheo), water puppetry...

### History

Viet Nam is a nation with thousand years of glorious history that can be divided into four main periods:

1. Prehistoric Era (from 2879 to 208 B.C): Kings Hung founded a country; Au Lac Nation was established.

2. Chinese domination period and the struggle for national independence (208 B.C - 938 A.D): This period was one of the fiercest periods of hardship in Viet Nam's history.

3. National construction and defense for independence (938 - 1945): This period was a brilliant era for national revival and development of the country and was marked by the glorious victory of the Vietnamese people against the aggressors.

4. National independence and socialism (1945 up to now): For nearly 100 years under French oppression, the Vietnamese people had constantly fought for independence. The revolution succeeded in August 1945 under the leadership of Ho Chi Minh and the Vietnamese Communist Party proclaimed its independence on September 2, a date which became the National Day.

During the following 30 years, the Vietnamese people continued to resist and protect their independence, Viet Nam has been unified ever since the great victory in spring 1975. Since 1976, the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam was proclaimed, with Ha Noi as its capital. Viet Nam enters a new stage of peace and development as a country.


### DAY 2 HA NOI – HA LONG




## HALONG BAY

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Halong Bay is a beautiful natural wonder in northern Vietnam near the Chinese border. The Bay is dotted with 1,600 limestone islands and islets and covers an area of over 1,500 sqkm. This extraordinary area was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1994.





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Sprawling Halong City (also known as Bai Chay) is the bay's main gateway, but its high-rises are a disappointing doorstep to this site. Most visitors opt for cruise tours that include sleeping on board within the bay, while a growing number are deciding to eschew the main bay completely, heading straight for Cat Ba Island from where trips to less-visited but equally alluring Lan Ha Bay are easily set up.



The best way to get to Halong City is by car, minibus or bus from Hanoi which is only 170km away. If budget is not a problem, an hour-long helicopter transfer is also available.

Located 120 km from Hanoi, Tam Coc-Bich Dong is part of the Hoa Lu limestone mountain range. For hundreds of years, the place has preserved the primitive beauty that has attracted countless visitors.





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The Tam Coc complex includes Tam Coc and Bich Dong, which are situated in Van Lam village, Hoa Lu district, Ninh Binh province. Recognized as a special national heritage, Tam Coc is often called 'Ha Long Bay on the land' for its system of limestone grottoes and historical relics from the Tran dynasty in the 13th and 14th century.



Tam Coc is charmingly beautiful in any season. In spring, bright green rice fields spread along the river banks, turning into silky yellow beds in the fourth lunar month. In the summer while traveling on the Ngo Dong River, visitors will enjoy an enticing lotus fragrance while listening to the locals recounting legends about each cliff or mountain in the shape of a tortoise or dragon head.





### DAY 1 HA NOI – SAPA

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Hoan Kiem Lake in Hanoi attracts tourists and locals looking to get away from the noise and frenetic pace of the city. Peaceful and quiet, the lake surrounds Ngoc Son Temple, a pagoda sitting in the centre on a small island.





Ngoc Son Temple was built in the 18th century on Jade Island in the centre of the 'Lake of the Returned Sword' or Hoan Kiem Lake. Legend describes how an emperor was once given a magical sword which helped him defeat the Chinese Ming Dynasty and in doing so saw the return of the Golden Turtle God to the lake.



There are also endangered large soft-shell turtles swimming in the lake, and to see one of these gentle giants is considered very auspicious. The name of the temple translates to 'Temple of the Jade Mountain' and is predominately dedicated to war hero General Tran Hung Dao who defeated an armed force of 300,000 soldiers sent by Mongolian Emperor

### DAY 3 HUE



## OUR BERTAL CHADE

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The Complex of Hue Monuments is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is located in the city of Hue in central Vietnam. Hue was founded as the Vietnam capital city by Gia Long, the first king of the Nguyen Dynasty in 1802. It held this position for nine Nguyen dynasties until 1945.







Many of the monuments surrounding the royal buildings were constructed in the early 19th century and were modeled after Beijing's Forbidden City. The wall that surrounds the citadel is six metres high and twoand-a-half kilometres long. The historical complex is known not only for its rich architecture but also for beautiful landscaping.

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The ancient site was the political centre of the country for 13 consecutive centuries and served as the capital of Vietnam for eight centuries. A notable attraction in the Imperial Citadel of Thang Long was the Hanoi Flag Tower, a renovated 40-metre-tall stone fortress offering expansive views of Ba Dinh Square and Hanoi City Centre.

## TUNNELS

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The Vietcong, alongside the North, dug tens of thousands of miles of tunnels underneath Vietnam. The digging began in the 1940s, and the Vietcong joined the efforts in the early 1960s. A key city in what was formally South Vietnam, Saigon (now Ho Chi Minh City) was the site of hundreds of these tunnels. These tunnels are now known as the Cu Chi Tunnels.





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Communist forces began digging a network of tunnels under the jungle terrain of South Vietnam in the late 1940s, during their war of independence from French colonial authority. Tunnels were often dug by hand, only a short distance at a time.



As the United States increasingly escalated its military presence in Vietnam in support of a non-Communist regime in South Vietnam beginning in the early 1960s, North Vietnamese and Viet Cong troops (as Communist supporters in South Vietnam were known) gradually expanded the tunnels.

Saigon Notre Dame Cathedral, built in the late 1880s by French colonists, is one of the few remaining strongholds of Catholicism in the largely Buddhist Vietnam. Located in Paris Square, the name Notre Dame was given after the installation of the statue 'Peaceful Notre Dame' in 1959.



Aside from its status as one of Ho Chi Minh City's most prominent attractions, Saigon Notre Dame Cathedral still serves as a religious institution for the local population. The best time to visit is during Sunday mass at 09:30.
